Marketing

We strive to provide you with relevant content and may send you promotional offers.

Promotional offers from us

You may receive marketing communications if you have requested information from us or have used our services and have not opted out of receiving marketing communications.

Opting out

You can opt out of receiving marketing materials at any time by contacting us or using the "unsubscribe" link in our communications.

Cookies

Our website uses cookies to track usage patterns and improve your experience. You can manage cookie preferences through your browser settings.

Change of purpose

We will only use your personal data for the purposes for which it was collected unless we reasonably consider that we need to use it for another compatible reason. If a change in purpose occurs, we will notify you and explain the legal basis for this.

DISCLOSURES OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA

We may share your personal data with:

- Internal Third Parties: CROSSTALK LAB team members who require access to provide services.
- External Third Parties: Service providers (e.g., IT services, payment processors) and partners that help us fulfill our services.

INTERNATIONAL TRANSFERS

Your personal data may be transferred internationally if our service providers or partners operate outside your country of residence. We will ensure that any such transfers comply with data protection regulations, including adequate safeguards.

DATA SECURITY

We implement strict security measures to protect your personal data from unauthorized access, alteration, or disclosure. Our procedures ensure that your data is handled securely and in compliance with relevant regulations.

DATA RETENTION

How long will we use your personal data?

We will retain your personal data only for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes we collected it for, including satisfying any legal, accounting, or reporting requirements. You can request further details on specific retention periods by contacting us.

YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS

What we may need from you

We may need to request specific information to help us confirm your identity and ensure your right to access personal data.

Time limit to respond

We aim to respond to all legitimate requests within **one month**.

GLOSSARY

- Lawful Basis: The grounds under which we are legally permitted to process your personal data, such as consent, contract performance, legitimate interest, or legal obligation.
- Third Parties: Organizations outside CROSSTALK LAB that provide services or partner with us to help deliver our services.

YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS

You have the right to:

- Access your personal data.
- Request correction or deletion of your data.
- Object to or restrict processing.
- Withdraw consent for data use where applicable.
